3.WELCOME BY THE CHAIR.

4.MINUTES OF THE LAST PARISH ASSEMBLY OF 18-4-17. The minute were proposed and seconded by the meeting and accepted.

5.MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES. The deeds for the Parish bus shelters are now deposited at the Archives in Northallerton. The licence required by Highways for the Street Furniture (village millstones) and the letters of consent from Robin Scott and John Hollins also deposited at the Archives. The Deeds for the War Memorial have been withdrawn and kept by the Chairman in preparation for future work on the Memorial.

6.REPORT ON THE YEAR. Hartwith millstone has been erected. HBC housing plan now with the Secretary of State for approval. HBC have agreed £100,000 on Borough play equipment, but largely on major site, and nothing in the parish area. HBC have agreed to invest £185,000 on Community housing sites. NAOB have objected to a number of housing plans in our area.

This is the last meeting in the cycle of the Parish Councillors and the Chairman gave his thanks to all on the Parish Council for their hardwork.

Thanks were offered to the Chair for all his hard work on the Parish.

7.INFORMATION EXCHANGE. The Chair felt that the coming year will be very busy, especially with all the work required on the War Memorial.
